

## **Moving Checklist for Buyers**

Moving home can be stressful, but our comprehensive checklist will help you stay on track.

Before Finding A Home:	
	Arrange your mortgage and obtain a mortgage in principle.
	Instruct a solicitor or conveyancer.
Before Exchange of Contracts:	
	Apply for your mortgage and obtain a mortgage offer.
	Book a property survey and review the results.
	Obtain home insurance quotes (you need to cover from the exchange date).
	Plan your move: decide whether to hire professional movers or do it yourself.
	Research and compare utility providers for your new home.
	Confirm your completion date.
Between Exchange and Completion:	
	Arrange buildings and contents insurance.
	Book removals company (or hire a van if moving yourself).
	Start packing non-essential items and label boxes.
	Set up mail redirection with Royal Mail.
	Inform relevant parties of your new address (bank, employer, DVLA, Dr, schools etc.).
	Arrange broadband, phone, and utilities.
	Check whether you need parking permits for moving day.
On Completion Day:	
	Take final meter readings at your old property.
	Remove rubbish at your old property
	Collect keys from the estate agent.
	Take initial meter readings at your new home.
	Unpack essentials first (kitchen, bathroom, and bedding items).
	Locate the fuse box and stopcock in your new home.
	Arrange for locks to be changed for security.
	Familiarise yourself with waste collection days.
	Update your address with the electoral roll, insurance providers, and subscriptions.
	Register with a local GP and dentist.
